Corporate prayers of confession

(We will declare these prayers together with time for silent reflection and personal prayer between each segment.)

Confession of Praise

*We give you praise and thanks, O God,
for you are good, and your love endures forever.
You are our only source of life and salvation,
and we rejoice in the gift of life you give us in Christ Jesus.
We confess that you are "Jehovah, our healer," and our Redeemer,
the One who restores us from all our sin and brokenness.*

Confession of Lament (Psalm 13)

*How long, O Lord? Will you forget me forever?
How long will you hide your face from me?
How long must I wrestle with my thoughts
and every day have sorrow in my heart?
How long will my enemy triumph over me?*

(Pause)

*O Go, we have all felt and spoken these things in our hearts,
for ourselves or for others.
We don't understand why some whom we loved were not healed
here on earth as we so desperately sought and asked from you.
Why, Lord?*

(Pause)

Confession of Mystery & Praise (Romans 11)

*O, the depth of the riches of the wisdom and knowledge of God!
How unsearchable [your] judgments, and [your] paths beyond tracing out!*

*Who has known [your] mind, Lord, [except you yourself?]
Who has ever given to [you] God that [you] should repay them?
For from [you] and through [you] and to [you] are all things.
To [you] be the glory forever!*

Confession of Faith (Matthew 6 & 17; Mark 9)

We come to you, knowing that you are opposed to the proud, but give grace to the humble. We confess that we too are part of an unbelieving generation. We believe, yet help us overcome our unbelief. We ask you to increase within us the seed of faith, for we cannot please you apart from faith. And we joyfully receive your truth, that the prayer of faith can move mountains.

*We join our hearts and minds with you, and pray in each situation:
'Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth,
AS IT IS IN HEAVEN! In Jesus' name, Amen.*

Scripture readings: Mark 16:15-18; James 5:13-18

Prayers for healing

Invitation is for all persons who desire healing in some way (physical, emotional, relational, etc.); OR persons who wish to stand in place for someone else needing healing (as an act of intercession).
